Community Supported Agriculture

Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) is an ideal way to receive the bounty of Red Dog Farm's distinguished organic vegetables, berries and flowers. A CSA is based on the principle that individuals from the community subscribe to a local farm by providing financial support in the beginning of spring, when the farmers most need money to buy seeds and supplies. In exchange, each member receives a box of produce weekly throughout the season. This mutually beneficial partnership ensures a more secure market for small farms and provides members convenient access to healthier, safer, and tastier food.



About Red Dog Farm

Red Dog Farm is certified organic by Washington State Department of Agriculture and certified Salmon Safe. Our staff includes: Farm owner, Karyn Williams, eleven full-time employees, and of course Red Dog, Rupert Dandelion, and his side-kick, Maggie.

The 2016 growing season will be our ninth season in beautiful Center Valley. Red Dog Farm has been under organic certification all nine years, and our soil has been augmented with rich manure and essential rock minerals to achieve optimal fertility. Our belief is that healthy soil supports rich microbial life, which in turn nourishes balanced plant growth.

Red Dog Farm is 23 acres, part of the original Brown Dairy. We cultivate 17 acres of the land; the remaining 6 acres is in farm buildings and a conservation easement, which provides habitat for birds and other wildlife. Chimacum Creek, which runs along the western boundary of our farm, supports Coho and Chum salmon. Working with and among nature is one of our foremost motivations to farm. We respect and support the wild and find that organic agriculture and wildlife co-exist beautifully at Red Dog Farm.

CSA Options

2 Share Sizes:

Small shares are designed to feed one or two people who cook half their meals at home and are modest vegetable eaters.

Large shares are designed to feed three to four people who cook half their meals at home and are modest vegetable eaters, OR one or two voracious vegetable eaters who love to cook.

Red Dog Bucks are redeemable for any Red Dog produce, flowers or plant starts at our Farm Stand and any of our market booths. Certificates come in \$20 and \$50 increments so they are easy to divide among family members or give as gifts.

By purchasing Red Dog Bucks, you help us by investing in the farm. And best of all, you save money! For every 200 Red Dog Bucks, you pay only \$180. Red Dog Bucks can be purchased at any time during the year and they have no expiration date.
