### **Responsibilities**

- The primary responsibilities are to harvest, wash and pack produce
- Utilize and update paperwork to record tasks completed
- Perform field work including but not limited to transplanting, hand weeding, hoeing, and moving irrigation

- Perform some of the following non-field work seasonally or based on interest/experience: greenhouse work, plant starts, delivering, tractor driving and farmstand stocking

- One season previous farm experience preferred but not necessary
- Flexibility and desire to learn new methods and farm systems
- Good communication skills
- Energetic, fun and motivated personality
- Excellent work ethic and positive attitude
- Team player able to work with all kinds of people

- Willingness to fully commit to the farm for the season

### **Compensation**

\$15.75- 17.50 per hour DOE, as well as veggies from our fields. Paid sick leave (one hour for every 40 hours worked). Weekly group lunch with all farm employees. Housing is not included. Employees who return for multiple seasons will receive an annual performance-based raise as well as an opportunity to increase/ refine responsibilities matching their commitment to the farm.
